

## Describing your work sample

*f. Briefly describe the work sample submitted. How is it related to feminism, social change, and the proposed activities?*

This is an opportunity to (briefly) describe the work sample. You can choose to give context for your work and why you chose this/these particular piece(s). If you are a visual artist, please list the sizes and materials used.

This question provides a wonderful opportunity to provide information about how the work that you are submitting is related to *feminism* and *social change*, KFW's mission and the very first criteria that the reviewers use to assess the applications. The previous two questions ask you to describe the theoretical and practical application of feminism and social change in your life and in the activities you are proposing. This question asks you to explain how the **work sample** you are submitting is related to feminism, social change, and the proposed activities. Since the reviewers usually look for work that is related to the proposed activities, this question also gives you the opportunity to explain how the work you've submitted is related to the activities you've described.

If you are submitting both your own artwork as well as work generated by participants from previous interactions, explain why you chose to submit certain pieces, how the art was created, and how participants' work (either from the process or the product) reflects feminism and social change.
