EXAMPLES:

Performing (as an individual artist): Grant funds will be used to teach modern dance classes that incorporate body image and self-esteem discussion workshops for African American women. The workshops will encourage, uplift and educate African American women by engaging them through dance.

Media (as a partnership between two individual artists): Grant funds will be used to collaborate to create a website that highlights women artists in eastern Kentucky, and to establish an online community of women artists interested in social change in this region. The activities will help connect women artists through a cyber network and encourage them to become agents of social change.

Visual (as a collaboration between arts and social service organizations): Grant funds will be used to partner artists with survivors of domestic violence to create art that reflects the survivors' experiences. The program will give survivors an opportunity for creative self-expression and advance social change by raising awareness about violence against women in the community.

Literary (as an individual artist): Grant funds will be used to lead a writing workshop where middle school girls are encouraged to write about issues that impact their lives. The workshop will give participants an opportunity to develop their voices and promote positive change in their families and communities.
